Volunteers can interview the short-listed Loyalty Pledge, 'Help A Needy Student' scholarship programme applicants, on an annual basis.

Scholarship Process - every year from February 16th-March 30th, volunteers team up with the LP management Committee panel and interview the parents and the RC student scholars, in terms of interviews and reviews.

Each interview is appx. 20 minutes. Saturdays from 9-1.00 p.m. Volunteers can show empathy and advise the students on how to achieve their target marks, be involved in sports and societies and how to aim at being an all-round Royalist!

Professional Forums

Careers - IT/BPO - Opportunities for being a presenter/speaker or a sponsor. Teaming Up with the EDEX Careers Team and being aligned to career development of students, by sharing insights and expertise.

Administering the Psychometric Test

Helping students to understand the rationale of the Psychometric test and select the best suited stream of study and also guide them on careers. EDEX - Careers Team/ Administering the Psychometric Tests 10 minutes per test: Volunteers can join the Careers team in January & August each year, at the EDEX Expos.

Mentoring/Coaching

For students who are scholars in terms of a sport, or even a selected subject.

Volunteers who are qualified and care to share their experience and time, can advise the new RCU Groups if required to set up their group formally.
